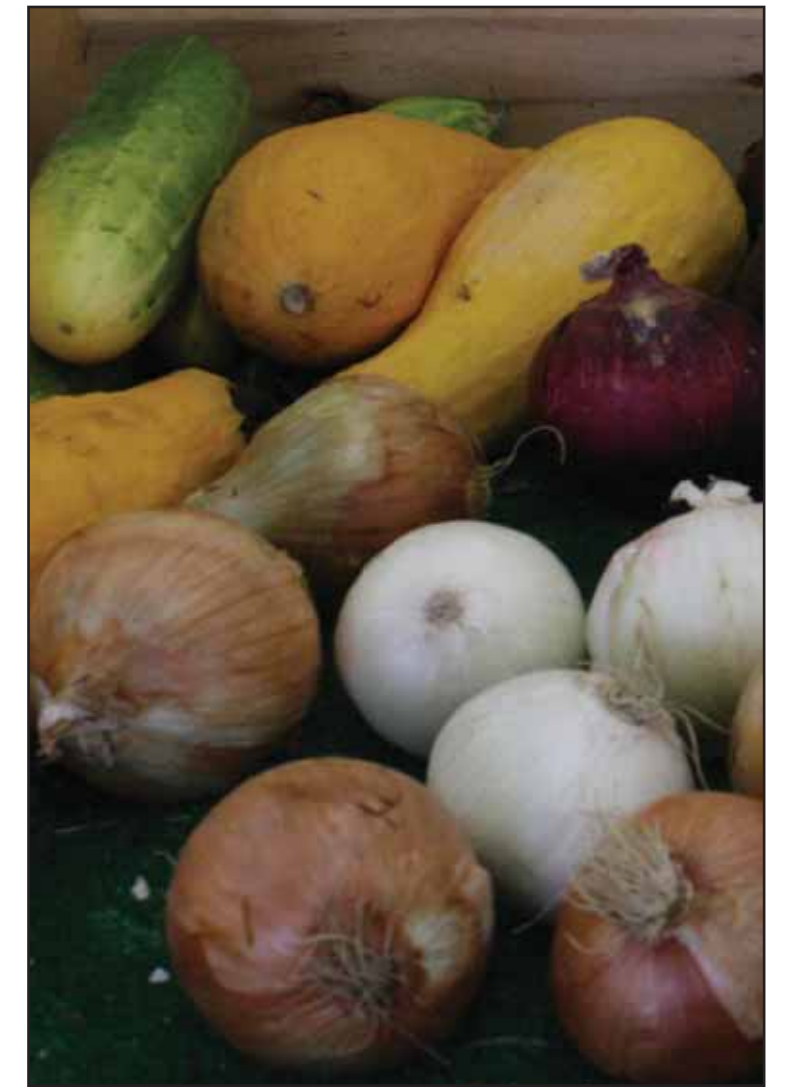

He quickly reaches into his pocket and produces a short stick, which he then demonstrates. "Very easy," he says as he brushes with the miswak, "and then when finished, right back in the pocket, ready for next time." Halal Groceries for Mindful Shoppers

Looking for fresh, halal, and kosher foods in White Center? Find them at White Center International Deli and Halal Store at 9613 16th Avenue SW. Owner Mohammad Nur watches his shop near the sunny front windows. "We've been here two years," he says, "we used to be on the corner of Roxbury." Mohammad's grocery offers a quiet respite from the fast urban pace with healthy foods for the family.

Fresh fruits and vegetables greet visitors at the door with red and white onions, russet potatoes, cucumbers, green chilies, lettuce, carrots, cucumbers, squash, tomatoes, mangoes, bananas, apples, limes, lemons, and oranges. Refrigerators are stocked with eggs, milk, cheese, and pita. Neighboring freezers hold chicken nuggets, beef gyros, salmon tenders, and paratha. Mohammad sells an excellent spice selection including coriander, anardama (ground pomegranate), asafetida (ground hing), chili pequin, ground ginger, whole coriander, Mexican oregano, 7 spice mix, turmeric, and many others.

The International Deli and Halal Store is stocked for the complete kitchen. Staples include grains and beans like whole juwar, white corn meal, brown rice, black turtle beans, small red beans, black-eyed beans, fava beans, and oats. Shoppers can choose from breakfast cereals, instant soups, apple juice, dry milk, and canned tuna, as well as halal / kosher imports: teas like Alwazah Ceylon tea with cardamom, three kinds of dates including Maghadi from Saudi Arabia, California dates, and baking dates, Lebanese-style turnip pickles, mango pickles, grape leaves, corn husks for tamales, Cortas hummos tahina dip, sesame oil, kosher horse radish, mango pulp, and canned sapota in syrup. Fresh baked goods from White Center's Al Shukr Bakery include boskud (cookies) and kackac (sweet bread dessert).

For healthy meals the whole family can enjoy, think fresh vegetables. The White Center International Deli and Halal Store has everything for delicious home cooking in one convenient place. Ask Mohammad for meal ideas, and he may suggest his favorite vegetable dish. "I like a fresh salad," he shares, "with lettuce, tomatoes, onions, and potatoes. Add a little salt and pepper, and a healthy dressing."
